(Payment is needed to complete registration)
Registering in person may take longer and does not have priority over online registrations.

- ### IMPORTANT INFORMATION
- Participants must meet the age requirement by the first day of class.
 - Unregistered children are not permitted in the training area, even in baby slings or car seats.
 - A parent or adult guardian must be in the building at all times for children 6 years and under attending classes and with all children in the viewing area at all times.

FUNDRAISING/BINGO

Fundraising is an integral part of Kanata to help keep the cost down for operations, equipment and maintenance. Parents of children registered in a program are required to do one predetermined mandatory fundraiser OR bingo per child per session. A volunteer bond cheque or credit card per child per session is taken at the first class and is held until the volunteer commitment has been fulfilled.

*****Fundraising buyout now optional but NOT APPLICABLE to bingo commitments — Ask us for more Information on the first day of class*****

Leduc Kanata Gymnastics Club reserves the right to change Fundraising or Bingo requirement as needed.

FEES

Each session has set fees based on the number of weeks classes run. If registering more than one child, in the same family, a \$15 discount is given for each additional child. We accept cash, cheque, debit, Visa and MasterCard as payment for classes. All classes must be paid in full with the required Bingo/Fundraiser volunteer bond cheques before any gymnast will be permitted to participate.

AGF FEES

All Kanata participants are required to be registered members of Alberta Gymnastics Federation (AGF). This ensures they are insured while participating in any activity related to our club. AGF fees are paid once yearly and must be renewed every September. This fee will be added to your first time class registration.

NSF CHARGES

A surcharge of \$10 will be added to NSF cheques and re-payment must be made in full and in cash before your child's next scheduled class.

REFUNDS

Full refunds and release from any bingo/fundraising obligations will be given provided written notice is given before the first class. A pro-rated refund less an administrative fee of \$10 will be given if written notice is received prior to the start of your child's third scheduled class. No refunds will be given after the start of the third class for reasons other than illness (a doctor's note must be submitted). Participants who withdraw after the start of the third class will be expected to fulfill their fundraising/bingo obligation to the club. Anyone registered in a class that is cancelled by the club will receive a full or prorated refund.

Did you know...

- *New 2019/20 waivers (PIPA and Notification of Risk) need to be signed for anyone entering the training area by the parent or legal guardian of the child, not just someone who is accompanying them. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCE will a child be allowed in the gym without both signed waivers.*
- *Due to insurance policy changes through Alberta Gymnastics Federation, under no circumstances is trampoline permitted to be used :(*
